SUMMARY OF EXPENSES: 2010-2011

BASE COST AND OTHER MANDATORY EXPENSES

This announcement provides financial information for the 2010-2011 school year. **THIS IS YOUR PRE-BILL FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR** and the document to use to calculate your total expenses for the year and the amounts due each semester. TigerNet on the College's web site (www.morehouse.edu) reflects an accurate balance for all students who enter a **complete** class schedule in the College's computer system, BANNER. To access the student's account, use the student's College-issued PIN number and user ID or the student may establish the parent as a guest user on TigerNet, setting up a User ID and PIN number for the parent.

Books and supplies, laboratory fees, and extra expenses are not included in the itemized expenses. A laboratory fee is assessed when courses require laboratory work. Students who take more than 18 hours pay an extra fee for every hour over 18. Part-time students, those persons enrolling in between 1 and 11 hours, pay **by the hour** for tuition. For easy reference, laboratory and equipment fees, for special privileges, and housing and residential life-related fees are detailed in this schedule.

MANDATORY AND ADVANCE FEES

Acceptance Fee (One-Time, Non-Refundable)	\$555
This fee confirms the student's admission to the College, activates the student's electronic student record, and qualifies the student to enter classes in the College's computer system. If on-campus living is desired, payment of this fee positions the student to receive a preliminary assignment in a residence hall. This fee is applicable to first-time Morehouse students only and is deducted from expenses upon enrollment. In the event of deferred enrollment, this fee is applied toward the then current acceptance fee with the student assuming responsibility for any increase. (Recommended payment methods are cashier's check or money order.).....

New Student Orientation (NSO) Fees. All students expecting to enroll at Morehouse for the first time are required to pay the New Student Orientation Fee. This fee covers the cost of program planning, special events, pre-class activities, room for boarding students, and meals for all students during the NSO week. **Students and parents should note that the NSO fee is mandatory and non-refundable.**

Damage/Breakage Deposit (All Residential Students)	Due July 30, 2010
This is a one-time fee that is required when the student initially moves into campus housing. It remains on deposit at the College during the student's residency on campus. If the fee is depleted due to damages, the student is expected to replace the fee. Once the student permanently vacates campus housing, the deposit is refunded within 30 days provided there are no damages to the room or the furniture beyond ordinary wear and tear. If damages apply, the appropriate adjustment will be made and the difference, if any, refunded to the student's Easy Refund Card.....

Housing Deposits for Continuing/Returning Students. These students make the appropriate deposit before selecting a room for the fall term and are entitled to a **preliminary** room assignment after satisfying the initial payment, which is due June 1st. Assignments are first-come, first-served, and **room occupancy is** contingent upon remitting the July 30, 2010 payment. The deposit is deducted from expenses upon enrollment.

OTHER EXPENSES

Individual students may incur other charges due to their unique circumstances or course load. Such charges include laboratory fees, tuition overload (19 hours or more), parking permits, and off-campus meal plans. **These expenses are above and beyond the costs outlined in the Schedule of Fees.** The following is a list of some potential extra expenses.

The off-campus meal plans are **flexible** (not meal specific). The student may eat any meal he chooses **any day** of the week, as long as he does not exceed his weekly meal limit. The meal week runs from Friday through Thursday. The prerequisites to activation of a meal plan are online application **and** payment of the appropriate fee. Only cash and approved financial aid may cover the fee. Apply on line at www.morehouse.edu/studentfinancialsvcs/index.html.

Any modification or cancellation of the off-campus meal plans must be done on or before the end of the drop/add periods. AFTER THE END OF DROP/ADD, THE STUDENT ASSUMES THE FINANCIAL OBLIGATION FOR THE SPECIFIED MEAL PLAN FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SEMESTER. Limited parking is available on campus. A non-transferable parking permit is required for all vehicles that park in campus parking lots and the parking decks. Morehouse students are limited to one parking permit for each semester. The parking fee is \$245 per semester. The parking office, located in the rear of the original parking deck, issues parking permits on a first-come, first-served basis. The requirements for a parking permit are enrollment for the current term, a valid driver's license, a valid Morehouse Student Identification Card, and proof of insurance. Any person, however, may pay the daily rate and park in the campus parking deck.
