First, be certain you have completed all of necessary medical procedures and college forms related to your health information. By now, you've been contacted by the Morehouse Office of Student Health Services to remind you about any missing documents. Your immunization records and your physical examination are necessary to ensure both your health and others at Morehouse. In addition, this information is required prior to you moving into the residence hall during New Student Orientation on Tuesday, August 18, 2009.

Please be sure you've satisfied the following requirements prior to campus arrival:

1. _____ Necessary medical procedures completed and health forms submitted to the college's Office of Student Health Services.
 2. _____ Financial requirements to be enrolled have been met. **(You must have at least \$15,946 on your account in payments and/or financial aid for the semester)**
 3. _____ *Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)* and any other necessary financial aid processes have been completed.
 4. _____ Housing Application has been completed and a room assignment received.

If you have completed the requirements above, then you are positioned for a smooth check-in process. When you arrive on campus, you will be allowed to go immediately to your assigned residence hall and begin moving in.

If you have not completely addressed the items above, you will be directed upon campus arrival to the parking deck or other holding area. You will then be directed to our Help Center, located in Kilgore Hall, where Morehouse personnel will be ready to help you address any items that prevent you from moving into your assigned room and residence hall.

Other instructions regarding check-in and the full New Student Orientation schedule will be available on-site. We truly appreciate you and your family's support of you becoming a man of Morehouse. Safe travels and we look forward to welcoming you to Morehouse!
